



Since its original proposal in August of 2006, a final decision on the Flyers/Wayne/Lambert drive sewer construction project was made by the Norwich Public Utilities (NPU) Sewer Authority/Board of Commissioners. At its meeting on Tuesday, October 23, 2007, the Commissioners voted [unanimously?] to proceed with plans to build city sewers in your neighborhood.
