

LEGAL NOTICE
CITY OF NORWICH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

At its regular meeting held on April 28, 2015, the City of Norwich Board of Public Utilities Commissioners approved the following electric solar rate and fees. The proposed rates and fees were the subject of a public hearing held on April 28, 2015, and were filed with the City Clerk on April 29, 2015. Rates and fees will become effective on July 1, 2015.

NORWICH PUBLIC UTILITIES
ELECTRIC SOLAR RATE OPTION – RATE ESOLAR

AVAILABILITY: Available to any customer with a photovoltaic resource whose nameplate generating capacity is less than or equal to 10 kilowatts.

RATE:

Customer Charge, Per Month: = \$7.30

Excess Energy Sales to Norwich Public Utilities: Reimbursed Monthly*

*Reimbursed at the average monthly Connecticut ISO-NE real time Locational Marginal Price, (RT-LMP) during the corresponding monthly generation period adjusted for system losses. Energy billing shall be performed monthly under the applicable rate, and reimbursements for excess sales to Norwich Public Utilities shall be made during a subsequent month's billing period under the ESOLAR rate. Total excess energy sales for the month shall be determined by installation of the required meter. Excess energy sales to Norwich Public Utilities will occur any time during the month where energy consumed by the customer is less than the energy generated by the installed photovoltaic resource.

MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum charge is the customer charge of \$7.30 per month.

LATE CHARGE FEE: A penalty charge equal to 1.5% of the unpaid balance compounded monthly is added to all bills not paid within 25 days of the billing date.

EFFECTIVE: For bills rendered on or after July 1, 2015
