

NORWICH BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING September 13, 2021

The September 13, 2021 Meeting of the Norwich Board of Public Utilities Finance and Audit Subcommittee was held via WebEx and in the 2nd Floor Meeting Room of Norwich Public Utilities (NPU), 16 South Golden Street, Norwich.

Item 1. The Meeting was called to order at 1:03 p.m. by Chairman Robert Staley.
